

# **TAP Marks Completion of Renovations to Terrace Apartments in Roanoke**

Total Action Against Poverty Wednesday morning marked the completion of a four-year-long renovation project.

TAP's been renovating the old Terrace Apartments on Maiden Lane in Roanoke.

The buildings were purchased by the non-profit back in 2005 to provide affordable housing for families in need.

"It's \$27 million worth of renovations that provided jobs with RL Price, It provided purchasing of materials. It's an economic boom to the area. But it's also good because it took some apartment buildings that were in need of renovation in this community in the middle of Raleigh Court and turned them into a livable, quality place for people that need housing," said Court Rosen, TAP Board of Directors.

The complex was built in 1950 and is still one of the ten biggest apartment complexes in Roanoke.
