

# Winchester EDA Purchases Nine Lots for Redevelopment

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The city Economic Development Authority has completed its purchase of nine downtown lots for redevelopment.

The adjoining parcels along South Loudoun, East Clifford and South Cameron streets sold for \$1.05 million.

Adams-Nelson & Associates brokered the deal, which closed Thursday.

Four of the lots, including the PERC fitness and health building, will be sold to the accounting firm Yount Hyde & Barbour.

The EDA is in discussions with Shenandoah University to use four of the remaining lots for student housing.
